# Christmas Card Workshop!

School Council is once again hosting a Christmas card making workshop! This workshop for students will be held on **Saturday, November 18th at École Good Shepherd School**. Students will have the opportunity to make beautiful Christmas cards. We will offer one session for students that afternoon: 1:00 until 2:30 pm in the school gymnasium.

The first family member registered will pay \$10 and every subsequent family member will pay \$5 each. A family of two would be \$15; a family of three would be \$20; a family of four would be \$25, etc. You can sign up and pay for the workshop at the school **prior to November 13th**. Please submit one form for EACH child you register, along with payment for all your family members together in one envelope.

We request that K-1 students are accompanied by a parent. Students in grades 2-6 can be dropped off for the session (although parents are more than welcome to stay if they like!). Please ensure that you are at the school at the end of the session to pick up your child(ren). 

# ÉGSS Parent Council Annual Christmas Bazaar Monday December 11th

It's the most wonderful time of the year!

All students get a chance to "shop" for a secret surprise to put under the tree.

You might be asking yourself, "What is the Christmas Bazaar"? It is a shopping extravaganza where all our students at EGSS shop for special gifts donated by you! They will all be wrapped and tagged by amazing parent volunteers and ready to be placed under the tree.

We will be collecting gently used and new items for this day starting Nov. 23 at Parent Teacher Interviews, and again the week of December 4-8.

It is a huge undertaking to get all students through in one day to shop and have their gifts wrapped, therefore students will only be shopping for family in their household (no pet shopping please). This will help ensure that everyone gets through the bazaar and that there is enough time to wrap all gifts.

We will be sending out a "shopping list" by the beginning of December, where you can fill out with the names of who is in your household. Every item is \$1 and no child will be turned away. Lists and money will be collected in the classroom at the BEGINNING OF DECEMBER. Stay tuned for that information.

- we will start collecting gently used gifts, wrap, bags, tissue, tags, tape and bows at Parent/Teacher interviews. Please look for the drop location in the front seating area of the school near the main doors.

If you didn't bring them at Parent Teacher Interviews, please send in your donated items the first week of December to your child's classroom and keep in mind;

- we need gifts for Moms, Dads, siblings of all ages.
- gently used items from home or new dollar store type items are perfect!
- if possible, please send in at least as many items as you expect your child to purchase, this balances supply and demand to ensure a wide selection of gifts for everyone.
- it would be greatly appreciated if each family could provide the appropriate amount of bags/wrap etc. for each member of the immediate family they are shopping for.*
